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## ABOUT our cover:

The surname BAIRD is originally from the south of France, but the first mention of the name in Britain came with William the Conqueror. There is reason to believe that some of our name came to Scotland in 1174 when King William the Lion returned from his captivity in England. Early spellings are: BARD, BARDE, BYRD, BEARD, etc.

An old tradition in the family records is that William the Lion, while hunting in one of the southwest counties happened to wander from his attendants and was alarmed by the appearance of a wild Boar, and calling for assistance a gentleman by the name of BAIRD, who had followed the King, came up and had the good fortune to slay the object of the King's alarm. For this signal service, William conferred upon his deliverer large grant of land and assigned him, for his Coat-of-Arms, "A Boar Passant" and for his motto "Dominus Fecit"- which arms are to be seen upon the ancient monuments of the BAIRDS of Auchmedeen in the church yard of Banff.

Some mottoes on our Coat-of-Arms are: "Vi et Virtute" meaning, live with virtue/honor. "And, Dominus Fecit" meaning, God hath made, Wear it well . . .

The genealogy of the BAIRDS begins with the religious persecutions of King James and the Test Act of .1681 against Presbyterians by Charles 11 of England. BAIRDS are an integral part of the history of Scotland, North Ireland, France, the Presbyterian Church, and our own American Revolution. Many of our name gave up their lives, their fortunes, their homes, to follow valiant if not always winning causes. Some were political followers of "Bonnie Prince Charlie," and others, for the sake of their religion, were forced to leave their native Scotland.

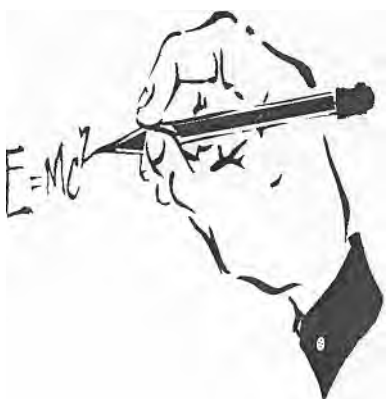

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# BOOK EXTRACTS

## NEW JERSEY:

New Jersey Archives: Biographical and Genealogical Notes by the late William Nelson, Corresponding Secretary New Jersey Historical Society.

Page 25 & 26: Samuel BARD was a son of Peter BARD, 2d, who was the second son of Peter BARD, 1st, a Huguenot, who came from Montpellier, France, about 1700, and settled in Burlington, where he carried on business as a merchant until 1723, and then engaged in buying and selling land, building and operating mills, &c.[sic], until his death, in 1734.—N. J. Archives, XII., 667, note. Peter BARD, 2d, was a merchant in Philadelphia, until 1734; within a few years after that date he removed to Mount Holly, where he was living in 1750. He took up several hundred acres of land in Burlington county, but sold the same in 1764. He died at Mount Holly November 30, 1769. Samuel BARD, his son, was born in 1740, and was admitted to the New Jersey Bar November 3, 1761. In 1765 he removed to Bristol, Penn., where he continued practicing, until his death, December 14, 1769. His will, dated Nov. 27, 1768, was proved Dec. 20, 1769, and is recorded in the Secretary of State's Office, Trenton, Li ber No. 14, p. 135. He appoints his father, Peter BARD, and Zachariah ROSSELL, executors, and directs them to sell all this land and property, consisting of a brick house at Mount Holly, and a tract of land ad joining the Iron works he bought of his father; also all his real estate, and after payment of his debts the remainder to go to his wife Mary, in fee. He probably had no children, as none are mentioned in his will. He was a cousin of Dr. Samuel BARD, one of the most eminent physicians in the eighteenth century, the first President of the College of Physicians and Surgeons, in New York.

## ARKANSAS:

History of Sharp County, Northeast Arkansas: **Published by:** Goodspeed Publishing Co.

Page 737 & 738: Jeremiah Pitt BAI RD, one of the early settlers and leading farmers of Union Township, residing one and one-half miles east of Williford postoffice, was born in Smith County, Tenn., October 10, 1824, the son of Jeremiah and Mary PENNINGTON BAI RD. His father, of Scotch descent, was born in Rowan County, N.C., about 1785, and died in Lawrence County, Ark., in 1857. He married in North Carolina, emigrated from that State to Kentucky in 1817, resided there for one year, when he moved to Smith County, Tenn., and from there to Lawrence County, Ark., in 1841. Mrs. BAI RD was born in Montgomery County, N.C., near 1791, and died in Lawrence County, Ark., about 1851. Our subject, the only child living of a family of nine, received most of his education after arriving at maturity, his parents being poor, and he being obliged to work instead of attending school. After coming to Arkansas he lived with his parents till their death.

In 1859 he married Miss Susan A. MORE, who was born in Tennessee about 1830, and died October 8, 1884, in Lawrence County. In 1888 he married Isabelle WASSEN CRAWFORD, a widow. Mr. BAI RD enlisted in 1863, in the Union Army, in Company C, First Missouri Cavalry, participating in the battle of Jenkins' Ferry, and was discharged in 1865. He has resided on Spring River since 1841, and has about 200 acres of land, eighty-five under cultivation. He has held the office of justice of the peace several terms in Lawrence County, and was one of the

assistants of the county court, when it consisted of the judge and two justices. He is a Republican, voting first for Zachary TAYLOR. He and his wife are members of the Christian Church, as was his first wife. Mr. BAIRD is an influential citizen, well-to-do and highly respected.

OKLAHOMA:

The History of Comanche County, Oklahoma:

Page 205: James Hamilton "Jim" BEARDEN, son of John Thomas BEARDEN and Lula Idella "Della" CAMPBELL, was born January 18, 1902 in Montgomery County, Alabama. His parents were born in the northern part of Georgia.

Jim BEARDEN married Ina Etta PATTERSON, August 12, 1924 at her parents' home in Stephens County, Oklahoma. Her parents were Matthew GREEN PATTERSON of Tennessee and Myrtle May SEYMOUR, born in Indian Territory, Oklahoma. Ina's brothers were Roy, Earl and Kenneth.

Jim and Ina met at a youth fellowship at the Denton Baptist Church, located about a half mile east of the Comanche County line.

Jim had a brother, Daniel Martin BEARDEN, born December 20, 1886; two sisters, Mattie E. HALL, born August 9, 1884 and Eula Mae JONES, born May 8, 1877. Eula resides in a Maryland nursing home.

The family left Alabama when Jim was about eight years old. They farmed east of Dallas, Texas, near Big Springs, Texas, and Altus, Oklahoma.

The BEARDENS came to Lawton about 1913. They lived in a rented house at 3rd and I Avenue. At that time there was no street over the canal. Jim, his parents and his sister, Eula, were hired by "Rase SULLIVAN to pick cotton. Later Mr. SULLIVAN became Jim's schoolteacher. The family later moved to a farm east of Lawton.

After Jim and Ina married, they made their first home on an Indian allotment in Zella Township, northeast of Lawton. Their neighbors were his sister, Eula, and her husband, Elmer JONES; Bert and Stella JONES; Jay and Bonnie MILAM; Felton and Jewel HALL; Albert and Oneida HALL; and Monroe and Lucille CLYMER. Monroe's father was an early day gold prospector in the Wichita Mountains.

Two children were born to Jim and Ina BEARDEN: James Howard BEARDEN and Betty Dean BEARDEN.

Jim BEARDEN bought an 80-acre farm located north of his parents' farm in about 1931. He prospered, had six work mules and several head of cattle. The depression forced him to reduce his mules to two. The government thought he had too many cattle so they sent out government men to slaughter most of them. They kicked them into a ravine and set them afire.

Not enough money was available to make mortgage payments. The family moved to the "Star" community, northeast of Duncan. It seemed to be the center of the dust bowl. Sheets had to be shaken before the bed could be used. The house was so poorly constructed, the chickens could be seen under it through the cracks in the floor.

The BEARDENS moved to a farm owned by Luther CANNON, early Lawton feed store owner in about 1937. The house was a nice yellow bungalow located one mile south of Bishop School, which is now South Sheridan Road and north of Wolf Creek. The farm was said to be the site of an Indian campground. It was a haven for arrowhead hunters. When the BEARDENS lived there, there was a circle

about 20 feet in diameter, packed almost as solid as rock. The neighbors said it was made by the Indians.

After a bad hail and flood came and killed most of the farm animals, the BEARDENS moved to Lawton and operated a small service station and grocery store at 1101 G Avenue. The streets were still unpaved dirt. The gas pump thieves and credit customers forced him to close the station and store. Jim was employed by the Crook Grocery Store and the Clements Apple House. It had the last hitching post in Lawton.

In 1942 the BEARDEN family moved to Medicine Park, Oklahoma. Both parents worked at the "MerryCircle" grocery store and gas station, owned by Odell and Florence HOUNSHELL.

Jim became a carpenter in partnership with Carl REEDER. He was a filter plant operator until his retirement. The family was charter members of the First Baptist Church of Medicine Park; he was a deacon in the church. Jim and Ina BEARDEN and his parents, John Thomas and Lula Idella BEARDEN, are buried in a family plot in the Denton Cemetery in Stephens County.

Pages 170 & 171: Adam BEARD (s/o John BEARD and Elizabeth MILLER) was b. 15 Oct 1828, Wash. Co., VA, m. 13 Jan 1853, Clinton Co. IN to Mary SHEETS (d/o Phillip SHEETS & Mary SHAFFER), was b. 24 Dec 1831, Augusta Co. VA. Mary d. 11 Apr 1904 and Adam d. 18 Oct 1904, both bur. Hopewell Cem. (Clinton Co.) IN. They were the parents of 8 children:

(1) Sarah Elizabeth BEARD was b. 30 Sept 1853; d. 14 Oct 1924 in Frankfort, IN; m. 30 Sept 1874 to Dr. Baltzer Lybrook GORDON was b. 28 May 1850, Union Co., IN, d. 22 Mar 1924, Frankfort, IN; both are bur. Grays Cemetery.

(2) Lewis Albert BEARD was b. 1856, m. 21 Feb 1884 to Sarah Iva RICE at Clinton Co., d. 1939 and bur. Hopewell Cemetery.

(3) Margaret Catherine BEARD was b. 31 Dec 1857 in Carroll Co., IN; m. 9 Sept 1879 to John Andrew RICE.

(4) Phillip Martin BEARD was b. 1859; m. 1st, 9 Oct 1884 to Mary C. POUNDSTONE SHEETS, 2nd, 26 Nov 1899 to Anna D. HUFFERWOOD (both marriages at Frankfort, IN), he d. 1924, bur. Hopewell Cemetery.

(5) Mary Jane BEARD, m. 1st, 18 Dec 1881 to Harvey Benjamin COHEE, 2nd, 7 Aug 1887 to John Wesley SHORT (licenses at Frankfort, IN).

(6) Nancy Rebecca BEARD, m. 20 Nov 1884 to Marion Edwin GRAY at Frankfort, IN.

(7) Ira Howard BEARD was b. 14 Apr 1865, m. 3 Oct 1886 to Mary Lydia KREISHER at Frankfort, IN; he d. 17 May 1933 and bur. Hopewell Cemetery.

(8) James Adam BEARD was b. 1867, m. 25 Dec 1890 to Malinda Alice HINESLEY at Frankfort, IN; he d. 1941 and bur. Hopewell Cemetery.

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TENNESSEE:

East Tennessee. Campbell County History: Reprinted from Goodspeed's History of Tennessee; Reorganized and Indexed by Sam McDowell and published by McDowell Publications. (Biographic Appendix)

Pages 8112 & B113: Jesse BAIRD, farmer, was born in Whitley County, Ky., November 24, 1826, the son of Lewis M. and Elizabeth WOOSLEY BAIRD. The father, a native of North Carolina, was of Irish origin, and left fatherless when a child.

He was born August 22, 1795, and farmed nearly all his life, coming to Kentucky soon after his father's death. In 1862 the Confederate soldiers took him from his home, in Tennessee, and tried, in vain, to make him take the oath of allegiance, and consequently imprisoned him, and he died in a North Carolina prison, in May, 1864. The mother of our subject was a Virginian, born of English parents December 28, 1797. She bore eleven sons and three daughters. Our subject, the sixth child, was reared on a farm in Kentucky, and since twelve years of age has been in Campbell County, Tenn. His country school education enabled him to teach, when of age, for two terms, and then after some employment in a distillery, he began his career as a farmer, in Campbell County, on his present homestead, in Elk Valley.

In 1853 he married Louisa, a daughter of John SMITH. She was born in Whitley County, Ky., November 9, 1836. Nine sons and four daughters have been born to them, but one of the former deceased. Our subject has been successful in life, and is a member of the United Baptist Church.

5. C. BAIRD, county clerk, was born November 16, 1841, in Campbell County, the son of William and Nancy BARRON BAIRD: the former born in Whitley County, Ky., October 19, 1810, and deceased in April, 1886. He was a farmer, and Lewis, his father, was a native of North Carolina. The mother, born in 1821, in Campbell County, was the daughter of Joseph BARRON, a Virginian, who removed to Tennessee, and finally to Texas. She died in December, 1861. Both parents are Baptists. Our subject grew up with country school advantages, and when nineteen years of age went to Williamsburg, Ky., where, August 2, 1861, he joined Company A, First Tennessee Infantry (Federal), and served with that regiment, until mustered out at Nashville, September 29, 1864. For two or three years he farmed, and in March 1868, he became trustee of Campbell County, and in 1870

was re-elected. He then farmed, at the expiration of that term, and dealt in stock until 1878, since which time he has held his present office with characteristic efficiency. He is a member of the G.A.R., Milton L. PHILLIPS Post No. 27, of which he is Senior Vice-Commander. December 17, 1865, Sarah BOWMAN became his wife. She was born January 9, 1844, in Campbell County, the daughter of Elias and Nancy DOUGLASS BOWMAN. They had six children: Synthia E., Winston, Calaway, H. Maynard, Annie J. and Jimmie N.

TEXAS:

History of Parker County, Texas: Published by Parker County Historical Commission, Weatherford, Texas.

Page 139: Samuel McCLEARY BAIRD was born in Lincoln County, North Carolina in 1805. His father was Samuel McCLEARY BAIRD, I. It is believed that Samuel BAIRD, I's, father was a John BAIRD, and his mother was a part Indian girl named Lovely Ann BUSHYHEAD. A Dr. STARR, who has written a history of the Cherokee says that such a marriage took place. Traditions tell of a BAIRD man who did not join with other, in the Declaration of Independence made by Mechlenberg County, North Carolina. For his own health he had to leave the area and lived with the Indians. Also, tradition says that Indian blood flows in the BAIRD family's veins.

The Indian wife bore John BAIRD two sons and died. It is believed that Lovely Ann BUSHYHEAD was only one-fourth Indian. After the war was over, John BAIRD returned to his people with his sons. Other stories have been found that we believe relate to this same John BAIRD.

A will has been found on file in Lincoln County, written by a John BAIRD, he names a son in that will, Sam, that has left his board and keep.

Hence we think our Samuel BAIRD, I, is the son of the John BAIRD of that will. The will of an older John BAIRD has also been found. The dates on this first will are dates that can make the first John BAIRD be the father of the second John BAIRD. We estimate that the first John BAIRD should have been born in 1720, and the second John BAIRD in 1750.

We have also made another assumption about these BAIRDS. They were surely members of the Primitive Baptist Church. The later ones were. We know, too, that a colony of that church came to North Carolina because of the persecution that was being made on them in Scotland. So it is easy for us to assume that our BAIRDS could have been in that colony.

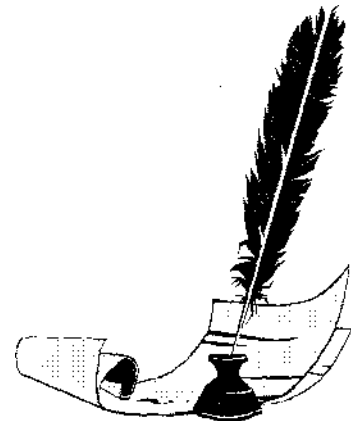
Samuel McCLEARY BAIRD, I, is listed as being in Hickman County, Tennessee in 1811. The list of children checks our list. The family settled on Duck River. Descendants might remain in that area.

Samuel McCLEARY BAIRD II, married Sarah NORRIS. She and parents were born in North Carolina. The couple were in Illinois in 1830 and back in Tennessee in 1835. They were in Van Buren County, Arkansas in 1840 and in Hempstead County, Arkansas in 1843 near Hope. The family was in Ouschita County, Arkansas in 1850. All children were still at home except one, the eldest. The children began to be married in the 1850's. Six of them were married during that period. Three of the married girls remained in Arkansas and lost their husbands in the war. Sam also lost tow sons in the war. In 1862, he came to Parker County, Texas, where his children had come earlier. It is said that several young widows came along when he did also. Sam married one of them after his last daughter had married. The wife did not live very long. Then Sam took a third wife. One child was born to this marriage. Sam died, soon after the child came, and we do not know where he is buried.

He had acquired a small farm in the Erwin Community, but we know he is not buried in the Erwin Cemetery. It had not been established.

Samuel McCLEARY BAIRD, III, was a restless man. He moved his family seven times and always talked of making another move. He was probably sixty-five or older when he died. He always listed himself in the censuses as a farmer. The wife was listed as housewife, but we know that Sarah had studied and had been licensed as a Mid-wife. She served the area she lived in. We think she was excellent in this service. We do know that her last child, James, was not given a chance to survive. He weighted only two and one-half pounds at birth. He lived though, thanks to his mother's training. Actually he lived longer than any of the other children. He was eighty-five at the time of death. The children are all gone. A grandchild, Flossie STRATTON-TOMPKINS, does live in Weatherford now.

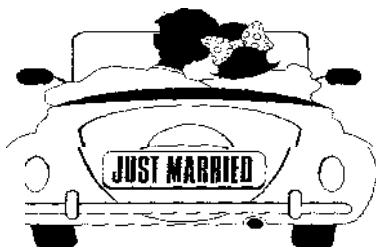

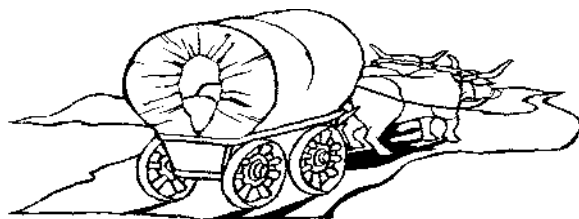

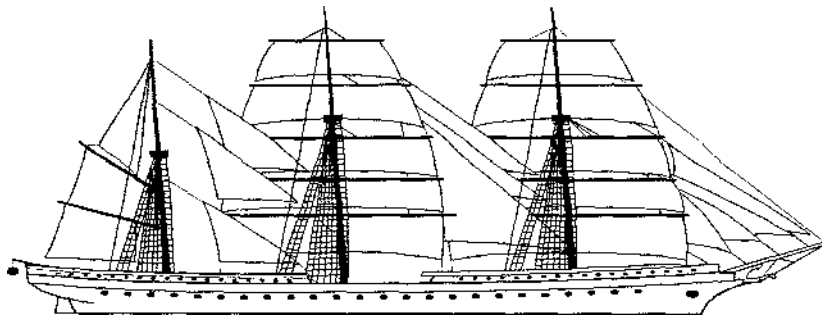

BEARD.—Edwin BEARD and his wife, Mary BELL, of Ireland, came to America and settled in Augusta Co., Va. They had—William, John, David, Charles, and Samuel. The latter was a soldier in the revolutionary war, and was present at the surrender of Lord CORNWALLIS at Yorktown. He married Sarah CRAIG, of Staunton, Va., and settled first in Pennsylvania, from whence he removed to Kentucky in 1792, and to Missouri in 1827. His children were—John, William, David, Samuel, Absalom, James, Mary B., Sarah L., and Elizabeth. William was a soldier in the war of 1812, under Gen. HARRISON. He married Elizabeth FINLEY, of Lincoln Co., Ky., and settled in Missouri in 1830. David married Mary DeJARNETTE, and settled in Missouri in 1827. Samuel married Rebecca FISHER, and settled in Ohio. Absalom died unmarried, in New Orleans. James was married first to Mary J. LOGAN, and second to Martha A. BRIGGS, and settled in Missouri. Mary married Gabriel REEDS, of Kentucky, and settled in Lincoln Co., Mo., in 1830. Sarah was married first to William **C.** FINLEY, and after his death she removed to Lincoln Co., Mo., where she married McKenly HAYS. She died, and HAYS married her sister Elizabeth.

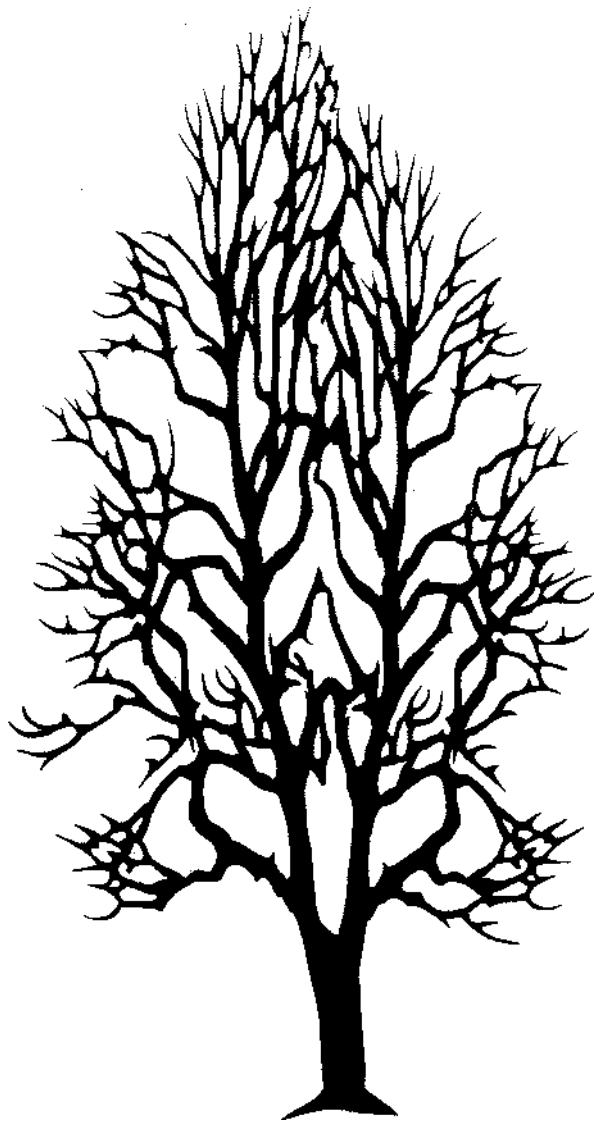

## Letter from J. W. BAIRD

February 1903

My Dear Miss Dawson:

I have been unable to redeem my promise concerning James BAIRD's Santa Fe Expedition of 1812, until now.

James BAIRD was born at Carlisle, Pennsylvania, in July 1767, where he learned the trade of "Blacksmith" and "Beaver Trap Maker." Was married in Path Valley, Pa., September 1794, and located at Fort Duqueane. In May 1796 moved to Erie, Pa. In March 1809 moved to Pittsburgh and in August 1810, moved to St. Louis, where he bought the ground between 3" and 4" and Spruce and Plum Streets, where in 1811 he erected the Shop, a picture of which hangs on The Walls of your Society.

James BAIRD was a personal friend of Lieut. Zebulon PIKE, whom he had known at Fort Duqueane and at Erie. Upon his (PIKE's) return from his exploration in Louisiana and Arkansas, he met him at St. Louis and learned from him the possibilities of trade with Mexico. At this time an embargo upon trade with the United States existed, the only method of trade being through the Iatan or Comanche Indians. Learning that the Hidalgo Revolution in Mexico had succeeded and that the embargo had been raised, James BAIRD, Samuel CHAMBERS and Robert McKNIGHT organized an expedition to trade to Santa Fe. This was "absolutely the very first" expedition organized specifically for trade with Mexico. The personel [sic] of the expedition was—

Letter from J. W. BAIRD (CON'T):

The expedition left St. Louis late in April 1812, going the Missouri River, possibly as far as Franklin. The last letter received from James BAIRD by his wife being dated St. Charles, May 1st, 1812. Thence the greater part of the route which afterwards became the regular Santa Fe Trail. The party reached Santa Fe in regular course, where they were at once seized "as spies," thrown into prison and their goods confiscated. BAIRD, CHAMBERS and McKNIGHT were soon after removed to the Old Cathedral Prison at Chihuahua, where they were rigorously confined until 1821, when Iturbide released them. Peter BAUM was shot at Santa Fe. On the fate of the others our record is silent.

Upon the release of BAIRD, CHAMBERS and McKNIGHT, the latter started for the United States at once. BAIRD remained two months longer. McKNIGHT was killed by Indians at the crossing of the Arkansas River. CHAMBERS escaped and reached St. Louis. When BAIRD started back he could find no company, so made the ride alone. This ride had been credited to one BICKNELL.

The war of 1812-13 breaking out the father of Mrs. BAIRD fearing an uprising of the Indians sent a Keel boat from Pittsburgh and took the family, with the exception of one son, back to Pennsylvania. This son, "James BAIRD" became one of Stephen AUSTIN's Colonists, was a soldier in the Texan Army in the war for Texan independence and was for two terms Sheriff of "Fort Bend County" Texas.

Upon his return, BAIRD found his family at Pittsburgh, where he remained about two months, returning to St. Louis in connection with his old partner, CHAMBERS. Organized a second expedition, which left St. Louis late in the fall of 1822. Were caught in a blizzard at the Crossing of the Arkansas, lost all of their animals and were compelled to spend the winter on the Island at that place. This was the party that made the "Caches" the remains of which are yet to be seen at or near Dodge City, Kansas, on the A.T. & S. F. R. R.

Notwithstanding the hardship and delay in reaching Mexico this venture was said to have been a successful one by those who returned. James BAIRD died of the croup, or quinsy, at "Paso Del Norte" in December 1826 on his way home. His family were not advised of his death until 1828.

Nearly all of the accounts of the Santa Fe Trade are in error [sic] in some particulars as to dates. Gregg in his "Commerce of the Praries" [sic] is in the main correct. The only error being the spelling of the name "BEARD" instead of "BAIRD." Inman and others follow him in the spelling. Inman in the third (3<sup>rd</sup>) Chapter of his "Old Santa Fe Trail" says, page 39, "The progress of the little caravan was without extraordinary incident until it arrived at the "Caches." This expedition (BICKNELL'S) was in 1814 and the caches were not made until 1822 by BAIRD's second party. Inman probably intended to say, "where the caches now are." It was by a letter from one of BICKNELL's men, dated at Franklin, Mo., in 1815, that James BAIRD's wife learned of his imprisonment.

The error in your local record as to the location of James BAIRD's "Shop, probably arose from the sale of his business when he went to Mexico, as he was in a Mexican prison from 1812 to 1821 it is evident that he could not have had a shop in St. Louis in 1817. I think that the purchaser of his business probably moved his signs as he moved from place to place as BAIRD's Beaver Traps were much sought.

The following from the records of the U. S. Department of State may be of some interest in the matter as substantiating the claim of James BAIRD to priority in the Santa Fe trade. The Benj. SHREVE named as one of his party is unknown to our record. The other citizens of the United States taken were trappers and Indian traders. Chotean was not taken until 1817.

I told Judge DOUGLAS as much of them as I could remember, and he asks me to join his request to mine that you would write them out for us.

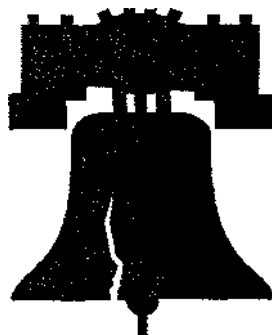

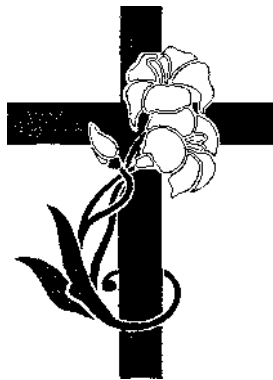

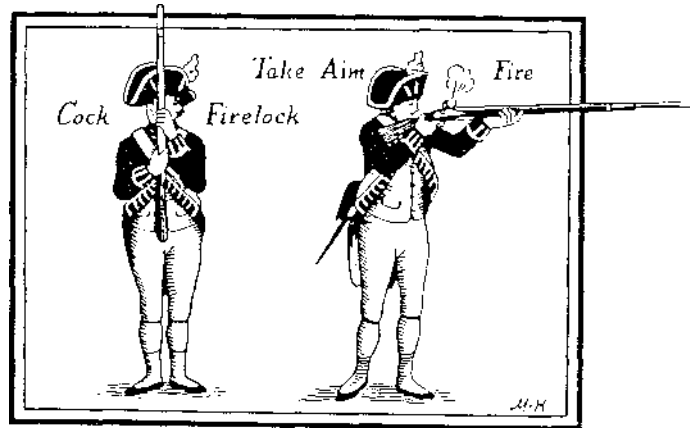

## + + + + DID YOU KNOW ? + + + +

The "Dictionary of Alaska Place Names" (USGS Professional Paper 567, by D. J. Orth, 1967) indicates that the Baird Mountains, in northwestern Alaska, were named in 1886 by Lt. **G. M. STONEY** of the US Navy for Spencer FULLERTON BAIRD.

BAIRD, 1823-1887, was Secretary of the Smithsonian Institution from 1850-1887, and was also US commissioner of Fish and Fisheries 1871-1887. He was a pioneering American naturalist noted for his studies of North American birds.

Baird Inlet, in southwestern Alaska, as well as Baird Glacier, in southeastern Alaska, were also named for Spencer FULLERTON BAIRD. Baird Inlet was named in 1880 by Ivan PETROFF, Special Agent to the United States for the 1880 Census. Baird Glacier was named in 1887 by Lt. Comdr. **C. M. THOMAS** of the U. S. Navy.

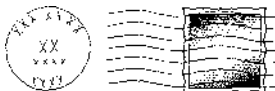

WILL OF JAMES BAIRD (BEARD)

**January 1808**

BAIRD (BEARD) Family Wills continued from " *The Baird Brigade*", Vol. 9, pages 44 - 47.

In the name of God, Amen, the ninth day of October in the year of our Lord One Thousand eight hundred and seven,

I, **James BEARD**, of Lincoln county and State of North Carolina, being sick in body but of perfect mind and memory, thanks be to almighty God and calling to remembrance the uncertain estate of this transient life and that all flesh must yield unto death when it shall please God to call. I do commend my soul unto Almighty God who gave it and my body to return to the Earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named and to the settling of my temporal estate and such goods and chattles [sic] as it hath pleased God to bestow upon me, I do give and dispose of in the manner and form following—

In primes, I give and bequeath to Meney , my dearly and well beloved wife, one negro woman, **Jean** or **Ann** and to have her choice of them, with her bed and furniture, one horse and saddle at her choice with her chest and its furniture and the cuppard [sic] with its furniture, over and above her third of my personal estate with the use of my house and the land on which I now live during her life or widowhood:

Item: I give and bequeath to Ester my daughter, ten silver dollars.

Item: I give and bequeath to my daughter Susana, ten silver dollars.

Item: I give and bequeath to my daughter Frances ten silver dollars.

Item: I give and bequeath my daughter Elizabeth ten silver dollars.

Item: I give and bequeath to my son William D. BEARD five hundred silver dollars.

Item: I give and bequeath to my son John BEARD that tract of land of two hundred acres joining **Tedey FORD** and **Jacob STONE** with ten dollars.

Item: I give and bequeath to my son Adam his horse and saddle.

Item: I give and bequeath to my son James C. BEARD one horse and saddle.

Item: And I do give all the land I now live on with all my lands joining it to my two sons above named, **Adam** and **James C. BEARD** with sixty nine acres which I paid taxes a number of years.

WILL OF JAMES BAIRD (BEARD)

January 1808

Item: It is my will that that tract of one hundred acres lying joining Wm. and Robert HUGENS, that it is to be sold for money.

Item: It is my will that all my negroes will be sold not above wiled [sic], and that the family may go together if it can be done.

Item: It is also my will that my son Adam should have the lame mare and colt.

Item: It is my will that all my property not above willed should be sold at public sale and what after remains after paying off the legacies hereinbef ore mentioned to be equally divided amongst all my children. If any of my children should die before they come of age, the share becoming due to such so decreasing shall be equally divided amongst the rest of my children.

I also constitute and ordain Capt. Jonathan GULLICK, Matthew B. TORANCE and my son Adam BEARD, Executors of this my Last Will and Testament and I do hereby utterly disallow, revoke and disannul all and every former will and testament by me made ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last will and testament.

In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal, the day and year first above written.

Signed, Sealed, published, pronounced and declared by the said James BEARD as his last will and testament in the presence of the subscribers.

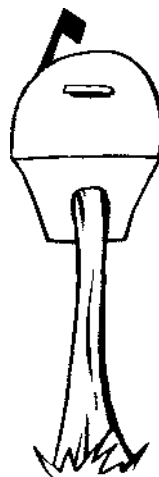
